Dear Parents and Guardians

It has been a busy term, as always, as you can see from the Oldbury Wells Journal. As you know, many local schools have been struck by a winter bug in recent weeks and Oldbury Wells is no exception. Thank you to our many parents who have supported us by keeping pupils at home as requested after they have become ill. We have worked in conjunction with Public Health this week and last, as have other local schools equally affected, who tell us this is a community issue. For your information, we have taken the advice of Public Health and followed all the guidance they have given. This has included temporary additional specialist cleaning at the weekend and each evening this week and alterations to site staff duties to include additional precautionary checks and additional sanitising on top of the professional routine commissioned cleaning service.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING AT OLDBURY WELLS SCHOOL

I need to ask for parents help, cooperation and understanding regarding transport to school. Unfortunately, Oldbury Wells Lane is very narrow with houses built very close to the pavement. This means that the council has been unable to undertake any real changes to the road layout. Therefore, we periodically need to remind users to take care and consider all residents, pedestrians and drivers when approaching and leaving our school.

On a related matter, we have been contacted by neighbours in Highlands Road, the other side of our West site. Vehicles parked on corners, parked directly opposite other cars and across driveways are making it very difficult for the residents to access and exit their homes each morning and afternoon. Parking on pavements has also caused these pavements to crack causing problems for pedestrians too. Can we please ask all drivers to take care to park legally and without causing obstruction? Your co-operation is appreciated.
