Dear Parents/Carers,

Now that we have all settled back into school life, I would like to present your child with the exciting opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument. We offer tuition during the school day on an excellent range of instruments: Saxophone, Flute, Clarinet, Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Cornet, Trumpet, Euphonium, Trombone, French Horn, Tuba, Guitar, Drumkit, Piano, Keyboard, Voice.

We deliver excellent tuition through our experienced, instrumental teachers. Some of whom are private tutors who visit OWS and some who are employed by the Shropshire Music Service.

Lessons offer very good value for money:

Shropshire Music Service tuition is delivered in small groups of 2, 3 or 4 and are £9 per 20 minute lesson.

If your child receives free school meals a 50% remission of the fee will be arranged, up to £45 per term. We must invoice you for any amount over £45 per term.

If you are in receipt of Child Tax Credit and Working Tax Credit and your joint family income is below £16,010, a 25% remission can be arranged (fee reduction up to a maximum amount of £22.50 per term). Evidence of your income via a remissions form will be required to ensure the music service criteria for a reduction in costs is met.

Private tuition is taught one to one for 20 minutes or 30 minutes and costs approximately £10-£14 per lesson.

NB: There are no remission of fees for lessons taught by our private tutors (Piano, Vocal, Violin, Viola)

Instruments can be hired so there is no need for parents to invest in a musical instrument purchase.

- I should point out that our Shropshire Music Service tutors will re-commence their face to face teaching in January 2021 (Brass, Wind, Keyboard, Drumkit, Guitar, Cello, Double Bass)
- Our Private Tutors have already re-commenced their tuition at OWS: Piano, Violin, Viola, Vocal.
