1.1H Relaciones con la familia (Describing family relationships)	<b>LG1:</b> To know vocabulary for how family members get on with one another. <b>LG1:</b> To know the difference between the use of 'ser' and 'estar'. <b>LG2:</b> To apply the knowledge to describe relationships within the family. <b>LG3:</b> To use adverbs of frequency to develop responses.

1.2G Hablando de las parejas (Talking about a partner)	<b>LG1:</b> To know vocabulary for different types of relationships. <b>LG1:</b> To know how possessive adjectives work. <b>LG2:</b> To apply the knowledge to discuss romantic relationships between people. <b>LG3:</b> To use connectives and relative pronouns to develop responses.			
1.2F Planes para el futuro (Talking about future plans)	<b>LG1:</b> To know vocabulary for relationship plans. <b>LG1:</b> To know how to form the immediate future tense. <b>LG2:</b> To apply the knowledge to talk about your future relationship plans. <b>LG3:</b> To use different structures to give opinions.			
1.2H Las relaciones de hoy en día (Talking about relationships nowadays)	<b>LG1:</b> To know vocabulary for modern dating. <b>LG1:</b> To know how to make irregular adjectives agree with their nouns. <b>LG2:</b> To apply the knowledge to comment on modern dating.
