## Re: Updates and Further Information regarding Year 11 Mock Examinations

Can I thank all parents for their positive comments and support over the last few days since communicating the situation regarding the positive COVID case in our Year 11 bubble. I am aware that there are always obvious concerns; for those in Year 11, the additional impact of having to self-isolate at any time (particularly in the build up to mock exams) is an additional pressure.

I am however delighted to have received fantastic feedback regarding the engagement of all Year 11 students with their distance learning which commenced yesterday. Staff in school have been tremendously encouraged by student's response; with parents and students who have further contacted the school speaking very positively of how things have started. My thanks go to all students and staff for adjusting quickly and commencing this period with such a high level of focus.

A reminder that all students should be following their normal timetable and school times while they work from home. Staff in school are preparing and delivering lessons through Satchel One and the use of Microsoft Teams, which are organised in line with the school timetable. Lessons will regularly include a live delivery, with staff being available for contact during allocated times.

Our tracking data shows that a large majority of students have responded to this way of working, where there are any concerns (for example if students are not online during the first lesson of the day from 8:50am) we will be contacting parents to make them aware. Our aim is to model a home study experience which will fully support all students moving forward. A reminder that for any technical advice, please look on the school website:

In relation to Mock Exams, it is our intention to run the full program prior to the Christmas period. Students have been working hard towards these since the start of term, if students are accessing the online lessons, we are confident that the support received will safeguard their progress. To ensure that the order of exams remains the same, we have made the decision to keep the overall timetable sequence, moving the first day of exams from Monday, 1st December to Thursday 3rd December, the day that students return from their self-isolation. A new timetable is attached to this letter showing the new days exams will now fall into.

On Thursday, 3rd December all students should arrive at school and go directly to the East playground where they will be collected and given further instruction. In addition, Mr Brown will be sharing key information via Satchel One to help students prepare for the mock process. It is important that everyone spends time watching this presentation prior to their return.

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I am extremely confident that the hard work that both students and staff have achieved together since our return in September will ensure continued progress for everyone. Information in the Learning Zone on the school website provides further information for all subject areas and can be used alongside the lesson activities in the weeks ahead.

My final message to all students is to remain focused, keep calm and simply do your very best. I look forward to welcoming them back into school and wish them good luck for their mock examinations.
