As we approach September, I wanted to send out a few important reminders about the start of the new term.

Return to School. We have a staggered start at the beginning of the new term as outline below:

- Monday 2nd & Tuesday 3rd September: Staff PD Days.
- Wednesday 4th September: Year 7&11 only
 - Year 7 students should report to the West Hall.
 - Year 11 students should report to the EastHhall.
- Thursday 5th September: All student return.
 - Year 7,8&9 report to West playground
 - Year 10&11 report to East playground
 - o 6th Form to the study centre.

<u>School Uniform</u>. A further reminder that parents are asked to refer to the school website for guidance on school uniform (<u>Uniform | Oldbury Wells</u>).

At the end of the summer term, we highlight issues related to footwear, skirts and piercings. Shoes which are of a trainer style are not acceptable, inappropriate style and length of skirts are not allowed and facial piercings and multiple earrings are not permitted.
