Heads of Year will have a particular focus on academic progress and supporting students to be actively involved with our Personal Development work and wider curriculum enhancement program; their brief is to ensure that all students are maximising progress in all areas of their school life.

Pastoral Managers should be the first point of contact for parents highlighting a concern and are available to give day to day support and provide further intervention and support for students who face any difficulties. Our **Pastoral Support Workers** will provide any additional support and intervention for students and families as required.

- **SENCO.** Mrs Morgan leads our SEND and Inclusion team.

As our new structures develop, we will continue to update all students and parents so everyone is confident about how our support teams link in school.

Where issues have been identified letters have been sent home requesting adjustments over the weekend and outlining further responses next week where concerns continue.
