Re: Welcome Back and Updates - Summer Term

- Uniform. As always, we will be checking uniform at the start of the new term; uniform
 expectations are outlined on the school website (<u>Uniform | Oldbury Wells</u>). Can I thank all
 families for their support maintaining high standards of uniform while also giving a reminder
 that <u>leggings are not permitted</u> as part of school uniform.

In addition, a reminder that from September 2025 there will only be one style of school skirt available for all students (the Trutex GST Gisburn Tartan Skirt - as shown on the school website). This was introduced for our Year 7 students from the start of this academic year and will be the required option for all year groups from September 2025, therefore if purchasing any updated uniform for the remainder of the summer term, it is advised to consider this update.

reminder that students should come prepared for these days with a drinks water bottle
which can be filled during school social times ie. break and lunchtime, to support them
