Your child has been selected to take part in a 'Raising the Bar' intervention within school that will run throughout this academic school year. All students involved have been made aware of their selection.

The purpose of this intervention is to raise the achievement of selected students through competition and reward. Students will be working with Joe Lockley who will be involved in the mentoring of students to improve their behaviour and progress. Joe is currently the owner of 'BrightStarBoxing academy' https://www.brightstarboxing.co.uk/about/ and has starred in adverts alongside Anthony Joshua.

As part of this programme Joe will be visiting students in school this week. We are hopeful this work will help to inspire pupils to make positive changes both in and outside of school.
