Re: Updates and Good Luck on Work Experience

I write to say well done to all students in year 10 for their approach and commitment over previous weeks regarding their mock examinations. At the start of the process we outlined the importance of good exam preparation and using the experience not only to demonstrate progress being made in their subjects, but also to become familiar with the examination process and the demands and pressures these bring. This period gives students the chance to experience this, reflect on their approach and help plan for further examinations in the Autumn term of Year 11 and beyond.

All students have done fantastically well and demonstrated an extremely mature approach in all they have done, well done to all!

You will be aware that due to the lateness of the examination series following an extended Summer exams for our current year 11s, we had a very short window of time between when Year 10 exams have been completed through to today which marks the last day in school for those students undertaking work experience. We look forward to receiving positive feedback from their workplace providers to mark the end of a year where all have shown commitment in all they do.
