As a school we have input from the BeeU 'Mental Health Support Team'. The Mental Health Support Team (often referred to as MHST) provide 3 functions as follows:

- 1. Deliver evidence-based interventions for mild-to-moderate mental health difficulties (this could be directly with an individual child or young person, a small group of children and young people, or with a parent/carer).
- 2. Support our school to introduce or develop a 'Whole School Approach' to supporting emotional wellbeing and mental health within the school.
- 3. Give timely advice to our school staff and liaise with external specialist services to help children and young people get the right support from the right service at the right time.

The Mental Health Support Team want to make accessing emotional wellbeing and mental health support as easy as possible and remove any barriers. As such they will be providing open access to school students through drop-ins.
