Dear Parent/Guardian,

Re: Work Experience / 14-18 July 2025

All students in Year 10 have the opportunity to participate in work experience from Monday, 14 July – Friday, 18 July. During this period normal lessons will not take place, students will instead report to the workplace of their host employer.

Work experience gives students the chance to learn about what type of job they might enjoy and develop their CV. We know it can be one of the most transformational experiences young people have during their education.

Students (and their families) should source their own work experience placements. The careers team and form tutors will do their best to support students to find placements but because we have limited resources, we cannot place all students. We need students to use their own initiative and support from parents/carers to make the placements happen.

We are using Unifrog (www.unifrog.org) this year to manage the administration of the work experience programme for example, collecting information from the employer about their Risk Assessment and Health & Safety Policy, as well as getting agreement from yourselves for the placement to go ahead.

Some important logistics:

- Students need to agree the placement with the employer **first**; students then need to add the placement to their Unifrog account. (They will find the 'Placements' tool on their Unifrog homepage).
- The Unifrog system will then email the employer, the parent/guardian and the school to collect the necessary information and permissions. For the process to work, it is essential that students add the initial information about the placement accurately.

Finding out more:

- Next we recommend looking at <u>this one</u>, because it includes advice on how to find a placement.
